

TDI Decompression Procedures

Course Overview

This course examines the theory, methods and procedures of planned stage decompression diving. This course is designed as a stand-alone course or it may be taught in conjunction with such TDI courses as Advanced Nitrox Course, Advanced Wreck Course, or Extended Range Course. The objective of this course is to train divers how to plan and conduct a standard staged decompression dive not exceeding a maximum depth of 45m.

Prerequisites

To enrol in the course, you must be 18 years old, show proof of 100 logged open water dives and be certified as a TDI Advanced Nitrox Diver (or equivalent), unless the courses are being taught in conjunction with each other.

What's Involved

This course has three components: Knowledge development, confined water skills development and open water dives. These will be scheduled to suit divers enrolled in each course. In total 4 dives are required with a minimum accumulated bottom time of 100 minutes. If Advanced Nitrox is taught in conjunction with Decompression Procedures a total of 6 dives are required.

Why Do This Course?

This course will appeal to divers looking to build upon existing skills to be able to undertake moderate decompression dives and increase their theoretical knowledge of technical diving equipment and diving physiology.

What's Included

The course fee covers instructional time and certification costs only. Students are expected to pay any boat costs and all gas fills required to complete the course. Shore dives can be used to minimise these costs.

What You Need

In addition to standard scuba equipment, students are required to have a spare mask, a delayed surface marker buoy, a spool/reel with 30m of line. We strongly recommend that this course is combined with Advanced Nitrox and is undertaken using manifolded twin cylinders. These may be rented for the duration of the course.

What It Costs

As with all our courses, the cost varies with the number of students enrolled. Whilst we endeavour to fill a course, we cannot guarantee to do so in all cases. Therefore we strongly suggest group bookings when possible.
